



Purse Pal Instructions

Orphan block (*8 1/2")

Batting

Backing fabric

ribbon

6 (*quart) plastic baggies

Choose an orphan block

Add sashings to make it 1/2" bigger than the baggies you want to use
Cut backing and batting the same size as the finished block.

Choose a button for the closure.

Cut a piece of ribbon long enough to go around the button for the closure.

Turn the ribbon into a loop and pin onto the right side of the quilt block (in the middle of one side). **Make sure the ends of the ribbon line up with the edge of the block and the loop is completely inside the sandwich.**

Make a quilt sandwich with the backing and the block RST and the batting on top of the backing.

Sew all the way around the outside of the sandwich, leaving an opening.
Turn the sandwich right side out and stitch the opening shut.

Press.

Quilt as desired.

Attach button to the quilt block on the side opposite the ribbon loop.

Place 6 baggies on the inside of little quilt with some of the zip locks towards the button end and some toward the ribbon loop end. Pin in place.

Stitch across the middle of the little quilt using big stitches. **Make sure you are sewing horizontally between the loop and the button.**

**Other sizes can be used to make larger or smaller projects.*
